Warm and comfy rooms to call your own

We have 80 bedrooms, all of which are bright, airy, comfortable and generously sized. Each room is furnished to a high standard and has a private en-suite bathroom, a digital TV, an FM radio and telephone points. Residents are encouraged to bring along some personal possessions so that they can really make their rooms their own.

All abilities welcome

Most of our rooms are fully accessible to wheelchair users and there are specialist assisted rise and fall baths conveniently located throughout the home. Hearing loops are fitted in all of our lounge and dining areas, and there are two large lifts so that all floors are reachable. We have a 24-hour nurse call system so that our residents feel safe and are within reach of help if required.

Safe outdoor spaces to explore and enjoy

Our 14 acres of spacious grounds provide a scenic setting for relaxing and socialising in the countryside. The private and secure enclosed garden areas, patios and nature trails get lots of sunlight and provide regular opportunities for gardening and outdoor activities. They are fully accessible, so everybody can benefit from spending time outside in the fresh air.

Space to meet, mix and make new friends

Brocastle Manor has lots of communal space where residents can take part in hobbies, catch up over cups of tea and spend quality time with their friends and family. As well as five air-conditioned communal lounges, there is a cinema room where residents can watch films while enjoying an ice cream and a multisensory room for relaxation. We also run monthly outings.

Fresh and nutritious food to suit all tastes

Our trained chefs prepare three home-made meals each day in our on-site professional kitchen, which are usually served in the dining rooms. The menu is varied and has multiple options at every mealtime. We can cater for specialist diets and individual needs as required.

Fancy a tipple?

Our residents love the fact that we have our very own on-site pub, The Pen-y-bont Arms. Residents and their visitors can sit back and relax with their favourite drink, enjoy a pub lunch or simply relax in each other's company.

It's also used for quiz nights and family parties. The nostalgic drinking spot gives our care home a cosy community hub, just like you'd experience in a popular village pub.

To meet the care needs of our residents, we take each individual's situation into account and personalise our care to suit them.

Protected and private

We want everyone to feel safe and at ease at Brocastle Manor because our home is their home too. In order to achieve this, we have the following extra security measures in place:

- A secure door entry system
- CCTV cameras in and around the home
- A full fire alarm system incorporating all safety features
- Safety restrictors on all windows
- Well-lit secure parking for visitors
- Secure WiFi

On joining us at Brocastle Manor, we assess each new resident so that we can ensure their current needs are identified and met. Throughout their stay, we monitor them closely so that, if necessary, we can increase the levels of care they receive over time. We genuinely care about and value all of our residents, so we make sure that they are as happy and healthy as possible.



Visitors are always welcome

We don't have set visiting times, so our residents are able to have visits from friends and family as and when they like. To encourage regular visits, we give relatives the opportunity to purchase a key fob so that they can pop by as they please.

Brocastle Manor is located close to the village of Ewenny, near Bridgend. It benefits from being close to local amenities and the wonderful Glamorgan Heritage Coast. The centre of Bridgend is only three miles to the west; the area includes high street shops, cafés, a cinema, a nature reserve and great transport links. Four miles east is Cowbridge, a quaint market town with charm and character.
