Our 60 bedrooms are bright, airy, comfortable and generously sized. Each room has a private en-suite complete with a sink, toilet and easy-access shower. Residents are encouraged to bring along some personal possessions so that they can really make their rooms their own.

On the ground floor, our bedrooms surround a pretty communal garden that gets lots of sunlight and provides regular opportunities for gardening and social activities. The two upper floors have their own outdoor spaces too, so everybody can benefit from spending time outside in the fresh air.

Woodcroft has lots of communal space where residents can take part in hobbies, catch up over cups of tea and spend quality time with their friends and family. There is a reminiscence room in which residents can experience nostalgia and memories of the past, which is particularly beneficial for those living with dementia, and multiple naturally bright atrium rooms. Our well-being and relaxation room, complete with sensory lighting and soft music, is a perfect place to relax.

Fresh and nutritious food to suit all tastes

Our trained chefs prepare three home-made meals each day in our on-site professional kitchen, these are usually served in the dining rooms. The menu operates on a four-week programme, with multiple options at every mealtime. We can cater for specialist diets and individual needs as required.

Our residents love the fact that we have our very own on-site pub, The Welcome Inn. Residents and their visitors can sit back and relax with their favourite drink, enjoy a pub lunch or simply relax in each other's company. The nostalgic drinking spot gives our care home a cosy community hub, just like you'd experience in a popular village pub.

We strive to provide high quality residential, dementia and respite care. Our round-theclock care package is provided by our highly motivated, fully qualified and friendly team.

To meet the care needs of our residents, we take each individual's situation into account and personalise our care to suit them.

On joining us at Woodcroft, we assess each new resident so that we can ensure their current needs are identified and met. Throughout their stay, we monitor them closely so that, if necessary, we can increase the levels of care they receive over time. We genuinely care about and value all of our residents, so we make sure that they are as happy and healthy as possible.



Protected and private

We want everyone to feel safe and at ease at Woodcroft because our home is their home too. In order to achieve this, we have:

- A secure door entry system
- A 24-hour nurse call system
- CCTV cameras in and around the home
- A full fire alarm system incorporating all safety features
- · Hearing loops fitted in all our lounge and dining areas
- Safety restrictors on all windows
- · Well-lit secure parking for visitors
- Specialist assisted rise and fall baths
- Enclosed private gardens
- Two large lifts

Visitors are always welcome

We don't have set visiting times, so our residents are able to have visits from friends and family as and when they like. To encourage regular visits, we give relatives the opportunity to purchase a key fob so that they can pop by as they please. Everyone is welcome to make a cuppa in the kitchen, just as they would if they were visiting a loved one at home.

Woodcroft is located in the middle of Trowbridge, a suburb of east Cardiff. It benefits from being close to local amenities and the Bristol Channel, which is visible from some of the rooms in Woodcroft. Cardiff city centre is just over five miles away. There you can find shops, restaurants, cinemas, theatres, music venues, beautiful parks and waterways.
